The Art of Bonsai

Bonsai is a living art form which enables the hobbyist to transform conventional trees into a harmonious miniature representation of a mature tree in a small container. Since it involves a growing tree, the design is forever changing and evolving. Some of the techniques used to achieve this miniaturization and styling involve the pruning of roots and branches, defoliation of leaves and wiring the tree and its branches.

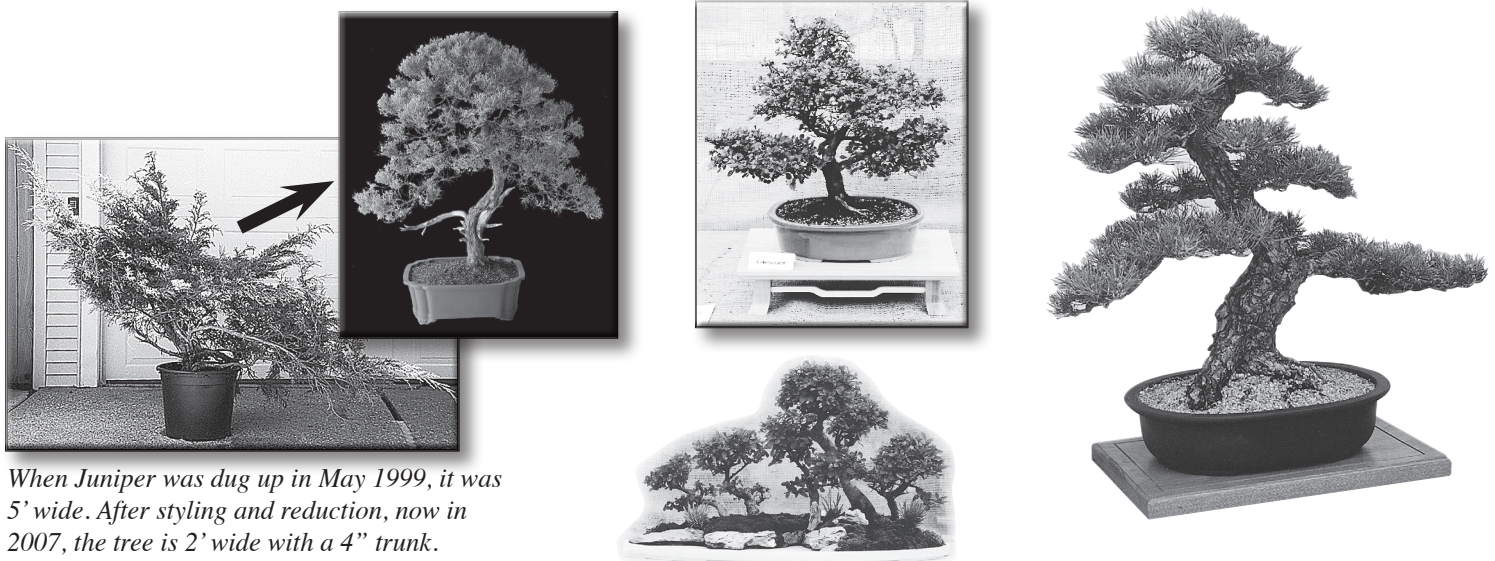

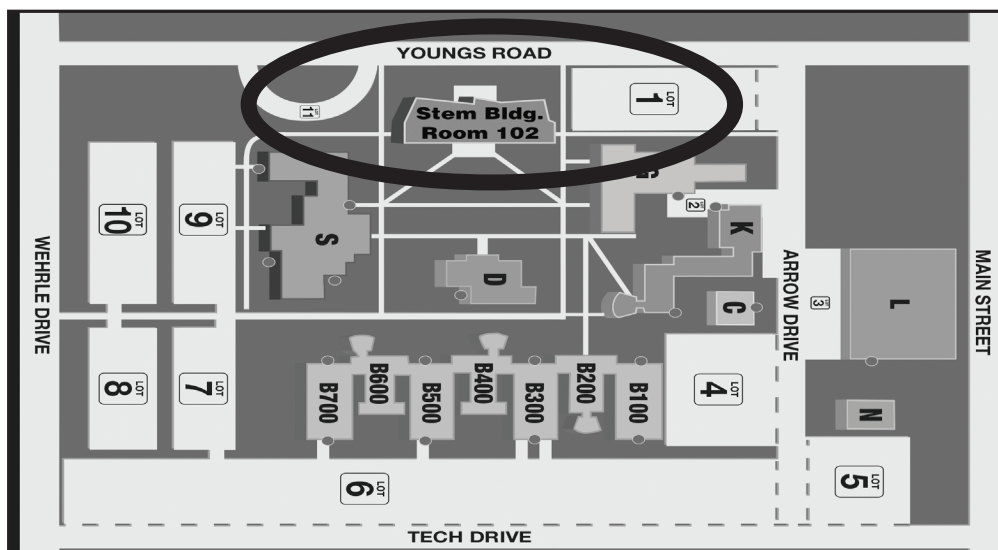

When Juniper was dug up in May 1999, it was 5' wide. After styling and reduction, now in 2007, the tree is 2' wide with a 4" trunk.
